“ I am deeply saddened with the passing of my friend, Ruby. 45 years after graduation she came to committee meetings as we were planning the class reunion. She very cheerfully pitched in to help, even to the point of donating cash money for our use to carry out our plans. She also donated money to my twin, Rev. Christopher Glover's church, where the meetings were held.

I heard from her several times over the years sporadically and then lost track of her.

In July 2015 the family had to put my brother, Calvin Gilbert Glover, in a nursing home, We chose Forbes Health Care System without reading the ratings.

When I got there along with the family, the place was just not acceptable, and we immediately started to make plans to get him moved. I was convinced by the administration to let him stay in the Dementia Unit on the 3rd floor, which I was told was their best unit for three days before we made a final decision. We were still not satisfied, and continued with our plans to have him moved.

When I was visiting him the first day, somebody rolled up to the door in a wheel chair and said, "Hi Christine" with a big smile on her face. I was so happy to see her, and we hugged and talked. I knew then the reason why God permitted my brother to go to this horrific place, just to find Ruby, who I had been looking for for seven years.

I visited her there, then she was moved to Woodhaven in Monroeville, where I visited and took her to some of her doctor's appointment. I got a call from her in November, 2016, which is still on my answering machine, saying that she was going to be leaving that facility. Because of several issues with deaths and other things going on in my family I did not get back to her.

In December, 2016 I tried to go visit her with a friend of mine, Gloria Davis, and she had moved, and I could not get any information from

Woodhaven. I called back and got in touch with someone who remembered me, and she told me where she was.

I went to visit her at Montefiore Hospital and was shocked at her condition. She was not able to communicate but was able to open her eyes and recognize who I was. I visited her often and prayed with her. I ask God to either heal her or take her to be with Him. He did the latter. And, I am so happy that she is at rest and peace in His loving arms.
